Milagros, (pictured above with a white shirt) lives in Porvenir, a nearby village. She was born with spina bifida. Her name means "miracles" and her mother has quite a testimony of God's hand of healing on Milagros. She did have surgery to close her spine after birth but many of the other conditions were found to have been healed at the time of surgery. Milagros had not been attending school as she does need diapers, which it is difficult for her mother to afford and she did not have special shoes that she needed. We bought her new shoes and she proudly wears them to school every day.

As I returned to the Porvenir school after my time in the States, it was exciting to receive the news that three of the students

with special needs had suddenly begin to progress. where they had not before. The teacher knew that it was because of our prayers and the Word of God spoken over them.



I am currently excited about a new project we are planning for a nearby village to minister to the children with special needs. God has wonderful things in store for these children.

I would like to introduce you to Rosa of Rosa's Kinder in Porvenir, a village about 20 minutes on the west side of La Ceiba. I was asked to visit Rosa's school to help with a few of her students who appeared to have some learning difficulties. What a treat it was for me when I arrived. Rosa's Kinder is a one room wooden schoolroom built on stilts, a gift from a visiting mission team. It is filled with colorful learning visuals and very polite loving kindergartners. And then there is Rosa who radiates joy, energy and love as she leads the children in songs and activities at a quick pace keeping the children involved.

But when you get to visit with Rosa and learn about her sacrifices, your amazement turns to humble appreciation. Her husband works in the nearby pineapple fields and she has four children. They don't have much and she runs her school totally on faith. She does not receive a salary or government help. Her school is solely out of her love for the village children who can't afford to go to school. She trusts God to supply snack food for her students each day. Many do not have food in their homes. God has been faithful and there has always been food. Rosa has a vision to help many in her village. She and her pastors recently began a weekend feeding program for the children in her village. Rosa is a woman of many testimonies of God's miraculous provision and grace. When we get together we "have church", sharing God's goodness.

Rosa is currently needing one, possibly two, surgeries and is trusting God to supply the funds. We know He will because that is the kind of God He is.
