

# Understanding Our Redemption

**Foundation Scriptures: Romans 5:12-14, 17-21**

**Read Chapter 2: Christ the Healer by F.F. Bosworth**

- **Romans 5:12**
  - **AMP:** *Therefore, as sin came into the world through one man, and death as the result of sin, so death spread to all men, [no one being able to stop it or to escape its power] because all men sinned.*
  - **Living Bible:** *When Adam sinned, sin entered the entire human race. His sin spread death throughout all the world, so everything began to grow old and die, for all sinned.*
- **Death:** {Greek} *physical death, and spiritual separation from God...*
- **Romans 5:14**
  - **AMP:** *Yet death held sway from Adam to Moses [the Lawgiver], even over those who did not themselves transgress [a positive command] as Adam did. Adam was a type (prefigure) of the One Who was to come [in reverse, the former destructive, the Latter saving].*
- Death, or the penalty of death, came through sin; sin was the doorway that brought death.
- Death had no place in Adam's life until he sinned, and through sin death was introduced to man.
- **John 10:10**
  - Everything that robs, steals, and destroys is under the category of death.

- Sin, sickness, disease, trials, and tragedies are all part of death and originated from the devil.
- **Romans 5: 17-21**
- **Hebrews 8:6** a better covenant with a better promise...
- Healing is part of our covenant.
- We are redeemed from every form of death and darkness through the blood of Jesus.
- **Hebrews 9: 11-15**
- **Redemption:** {Greek} *paid ransom, to release, to buy out....*
- **I John 3:8**
- Jesus gave his life as a sacrifice to set us free from the dominion of the devil and every form of darkness.
- **Romans 3:24**
  - **AMP:** *[All] are justified and made upright and in right standing with God, freely and gratuitously by His grace (His unmerited favor and mercy), through the redemption which is [provided] in Christ Jesus,*
  - **Passion:** *Yet through his powerful declaration of acquittal, God freely gives away his righteousness. His gift of love and favor now cascades over us, all because Jesus, the Anointed One, has liberated us from the guilt, punishment, and power of sin!*
- **Colossians 1:9-14**

- We have been redeemed from the kingdom of darkness and put into the kingdom of God.
- **Colossians 1:13** *Hath* redeemed us!
- Redemption is for the whole man — **spirit, soul, body**.
