## ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

In His entire earthly ministry, Jesus was completely dependent upon the Holy Spirit. Before the Holy Spirit descended upon Him at the river Jordan, He never preached a sermon or performed a miracle. After that, all He did was by the power of the Holy Spirit. When He was about to leave His disciples, He promised that from heaven He would send the Holy Spirit to them in their turn, to be their Comforter and to supply all their spiritual needs. This promise was fulfilled on the day of Pentecost when they were all baptized in the Holy Spirit.

Note: The two English expressions "Holy Spirit" and "Holy Ghost" are two different ways of translating one and the same expression in the original Greek of the New Testament. There is therefore no difference in meaning between the two expressions.
